ROOM 9 SHOWCASE




Hello Taparra Families, welcome to Room 9. We would like to say welcome to all the new students and their families. We hope you love Taparra as much as we do.

This semester Room 9 will be learning lots of new concepts.

We are working hard to complete our morning and afternoon jobs independently and recognising that we need to take care and be responsible for our own belongings.

In English we have been building on our Phonological Awareness skills such as rhyming, beginning, and ending sounds, blending, and segmenting compound words and adding/deleting and substituting parts of words to make new words. We are getting so much better at it even after only four weeks. We are also learning letters and sounds these are called graphemes and phonemes. We have already learnt 'm, s, t and a". Now that we have these phonemes and graphemes, we will start to blend them together to make words and then segment them to write words.

All types of School Card applications are now online.

You can access the online forms from any device that gets internet, including mobile devices, such as tablets and smart phones, as well as laptops and computers.

Applying online is easy! Simply follow the steps below.

- STEP 1 Visit sa_gov_au/education/schoolcard
- STEP 2 Select the type of School Card you would like to apply for (for example 'Type A') and follow the prompts.
- STEP 3 Complete all mandatory fields.

Please note: you cannot submit your application unless all mandatory fields are complete.

- **STEP 4** Once you have completed a page click on the 'NEXT' button.
- STEP 5 Once you have filled out all pages click the 'SUBMIT' button.

 Please note: if you exit the form without clicking 'SUBMIT' your details will be lost.

You can save the form, and return to complete it at another time, by clicking on the 'SAVE' button.
